SWIMMING POOL RULES

REVISED May 2008

Posted May 9, 2008 / Effective May 23, 2008

The following rules have been established to assure safe and sanitary operation of the Jefferson Yacht Club swimming pool facilities. Parents are responsible for their children at all times and are required to observe all rules and obey instructions of the pool management for the protection and benefit of all members.

1. Pool hours will be posted and may be subject to change without notice. The use of the pool during other hours is prohibited, except in the case of special events as determined by Club Management.
2. All members, including children and guests shall use the pool and its facilities at their own risk. Jefferson Yacht Club assumes no responsibility for injury or damage resulting from such use. There is no lifeguard on duty.
3. Members will bring their own towels.
4. The club will not be responsible for loss or damage to personal property.
5. Glass containers of any type are strictly prohibited outside.
6. Popcorn is strictly prohibited outside.
7. No food or beverages shall be brought into the pool area unless special arrangements are made with the Club Director/Manager. Food and beverages are available at the club for purchase.
8. A shower must be taken before entering the pool. No swimming is allowed in cut-offs, jeans, clothing, make-shift suits, etc.
9. Abusive language and boisterous conduct, running, splashing, jumping, shoving, dunking, throwing others into the pool, or attempting feats beyond skills or endurance will not be allowed.
10. Persons wearing bandages or suffering from an infection shall not use the swimming pool.
11. Members will be held responsible for the conduct of their family and guests and for the adherence of their family and guests to all rules.
12. All complaints and objections should be referred to Club Management.
13. No wet bathing suits are allowed in the clubhouse at anytime. Cover-ups, shirts and shoes must be worn in the clubhouse.
14. Children under 16 must be accompanied by a parent or responsible adult. There is no baby-sitting provided by the Jefferson Yacht Club.
15. Unaccompanied children of members 16 years or older are permitted a maximum of two guests per visit unless prior arrangements have been made with Club Management.
16. In order to maintain the pool facility for the exclusive use of the membership, it is necessary that all members be prepared to show their Membership Card to Club Employees, Club Director/Manager or any Board Director if asked. Guests of Members must sign in.
17. These rules shall be enforced by the Club Director/Manager or a designate and may at their discretion take away pool privileges if the behavior of any child or adult is not in accordance with the pool rules.
